Chapter 111, Sections 150A and 150A1/2, and the Massachusetts Solid Waste Regulations at 310 CMR 16.00, that the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) has issued the following for the Holyoke Masonry Products, LLC (HMP) property at 20

Water St., Holyoke, MA: a **Draft Recycling, Composting or Conversion (RCC)** permit for a Recycling Operation.

The application by the proposed Operator, HMP, proposes to accept, process (crush), handle and store clean Asphalt, Brick & Concrete (ABC) rubble within a designated area of the HMP property (the Site). The hours of operation will be Monday-Friday 7:00 AM to 4:30 PM. ABC rubble will be pre-sorted and source-separated prior to acceptance at the Site, and will consist only of clean (i.e., not painted, coated or otherwise contaminated) ABC rubble. The maximum amount of ABC rubble accepted in one calendar year will be 30,300 tons, and the maximum amount of ABC rubble accepted in any one day will be 100 tons. All incoming and outgoing trucks transporting ABC rubble into and out of the Site will use the existing HMP site access road off Water Street.

Copies of MassDEP's Draft permit are available for copying an examination along with the application at the Department's Western Regional Office, 436 Dwight Street, Springfield, MA 01103, and at the Holyoke Health Department, 20 Korean Veterans Plaza #306, Holyoke, MA 01040.

**Repair and Resurfacing of Tennis Courts**

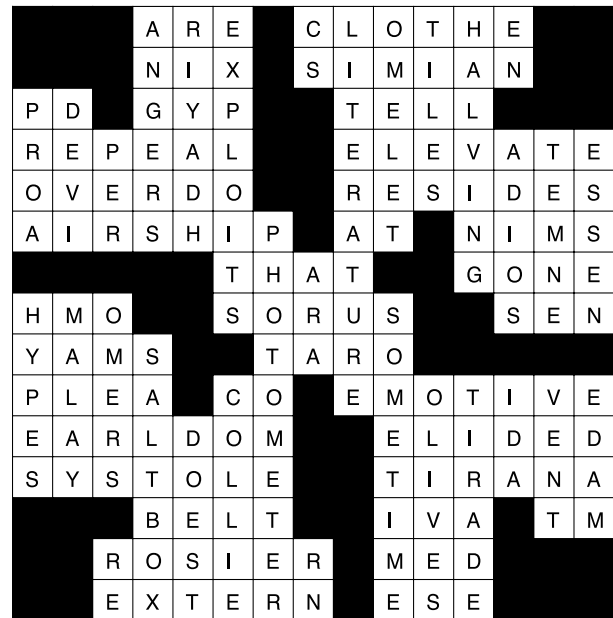
