A Design Public Informational Meeting will be held by MassDOT to discuss the proposed Improvements to Lower Westfield Road on I-91 (Interchange 15) project in Holyoke, MA.

WHEN: **Wednesday, July 19, 2017 at 7:00 PM**
PURPOSE: The purpose of this meeting is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed improvements to Lower Westfield Road on I-91 (Interchange 15) project. All views and comments made at the meeting will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

PROPOSAL: The proposed project consists of improving safety and traffic accommodation in the corridor beneath the I-91 bridges on Lower Westfield Road. Included in this work is the resurfacing of Lower Westfield Road within the project limits, some minor full depth pavement reconstruction, new pavement markings, and construction of a new sidewalk with related wheel chair ramps. In addition, bicycle accommodations consisting of a usable shoulder have been provided in accordance with applicable design guides.

A secure right-of-way is necessary for this project. Acquisitions in fee and permanent or temporary easements may be required. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts is responsible for acquiring all needed rights in private or public lands. MassDOT's policy concerning land acquisitions will be discussed at this meeting.

Written views received by MassDOT subsequent to the date of this notice and up to five (5) days prior to the date of the meeting shall be displayed for public inspection and copying at the time and date listed above. Plans will be on display one-half hour before the meeting begins, with an engineer in attendance to answer questions regarding this project. A project handout will be made available on the MassDOT website listed below.

Written statements and other exhibits in place of, or in addition to, oral statements made at the Public Informational Meeting regarding the proposed undertaking are to be submitted to Patricia A. Leavenworth, P.E., Chief Engineer, MassDOT, 10 Park Plaza, Boston, MA 02116, Attention: Highway Design, Project File No. 606903. Such submissions will also be accepted at the meeting.
