advantage. Holyoke had one last possession with 3:09 to play and 14 plays later, they were on fourth and nine on the Minnechaug 16 with four second to play. A pass into the end zone was knocked down and Minnechaug emerged with the win.

The Knights received, and their first drive was marked by the running of Giovanni Carrasquillo. He had eight carries for 38 yards. Holyoke moved the ball from their 13-yard line to the Minnechaug 26, before they gave up the ball on downs. Minnechaug started at their 28 and went 72 yards in seven plays for a touchdown. They opened with runs of 15 and 7 for Jamel Smith, along with a 30-yard pass from Anthony Izzo to Devin Rice and a 27-yard touchdown strike on fourth and seven from Izzo to Dan Sheehan. Minnechaug led 7-0.

Seconds into the second quarter, Minnechaug

made it 13-0 as Smith ran 28 yards for a touchdown. Holyoke responded with a 48-yard drive on five plays in 2:25. When Carrasquillo took it in from 16 yards, with 9:17 to go, he had 80 yards on 14 carries. Holyoke made good with a 74-yard, six play drive to get their first lead at 14-13. Along with runs of 3, 11 and 4 by Carrasquillo and 15 by Colon, Jose Luciano caught a 41-yard touchdown pass. The extra point put the Knights in the lead. Back came Minnechaug and in 2:15, they regained the lead on an Ethan Moretti run. The drive was kept alive by a 47-yard pass to Chris Patrick on third and five. The halftime score was 19-14.

In the third, there were eight possessions. Five ended with turnovers. Holyoke fumbled twice and Minnechaug, once. Each team threw an interception. There was very little net gain. The third started on the Minnechaug 39 and ended on their 32.

Holyoke scored three minutes into the fourth, as Owen Lavelle ran in a fumble from the Falcons 10. Colon picked up the two-point conversion and it was 22-19. Minnechaug responded again, going 75 yards in seven plays. On third and five, Izzo hit Sheehan for a 53 yard pick up. On third and six from the seven for a touchdown and a 26-22 score.

The final drive began at the Holyoke 22 with Kendrick Williams' runs of 12 and 5. Colon completed passes to Joseph Dumoulin for 15, 11 and 12. On fourth and nine from the 16, Brian Anderson and Michael Talaia got in front of a Colon pass and knocked it down.

Izzo was 9-for-15 with 171 yards and two touchdowns. Sheehan caught five for 81 yards with one touchdown. Smith ran for 78 on 26 carries and one touchdown. Colon, 6 for 15, had 81 yards and a touchdown pass. Dumoulin caught four for 27 yards and Luciano had one for 41 yards and a touchdown. Carrasquillo ran 28 times for 156 yards. Colon ad ten carries for 62 yards.
