The subject matter of the proposed amendments to the Zoning By-Law and Zoning Map is as follows:

Article PB-01: To see if the Town will vote to amend in the Zoning By-Law Section 3 DEFINITIONS, Subpart (B) Definitions to insert the term and define "Microbrewery" and renumber the definitions in alphabetical order; Section 5 USE REGULATIONS, Subpart (E) Use Regulations Schedule to incorporate the use "Microbrewery" into the Industrial Uses classification and provide whether they are permitted by Right, Site Plan Review, and/or Special Permit in various zoning districts and change the use "Retail Sales" (in the Business Uses classification" from "prohibited" in the Industrial A zoning district to "permitted by Site Plan Review" in the Industrial A zoning district subject to a footnote and insert a footnote regarding restrictions on the "Retail Sales" use in the Industrial A zoning district (as detailed in the Planning Board Report) or take any other action relative thereto.
