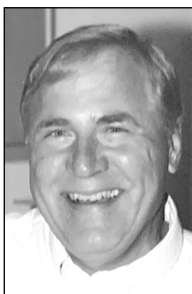

## Walter C. Jaworski



Walter C. Jaworski, 71, of Northfield, Ma. died unexpectedly at his home Monday (2-14-2022) with his wife by his side. He was born on April 27, 1950, the son of Walter and Mary (Podlenski) Jaworski. He attended the Albany Academy, and Cornell University where he earned his undergraduate degree and his doctorate of Veterinary Medicine in 1976. He started his own practice in Athol, Mass. and a second in Gardner, Mass. After retiring from his practice he joined the teaching faculty at Holyoke Community College

and became the coordinator for their Veterarian Technican program. 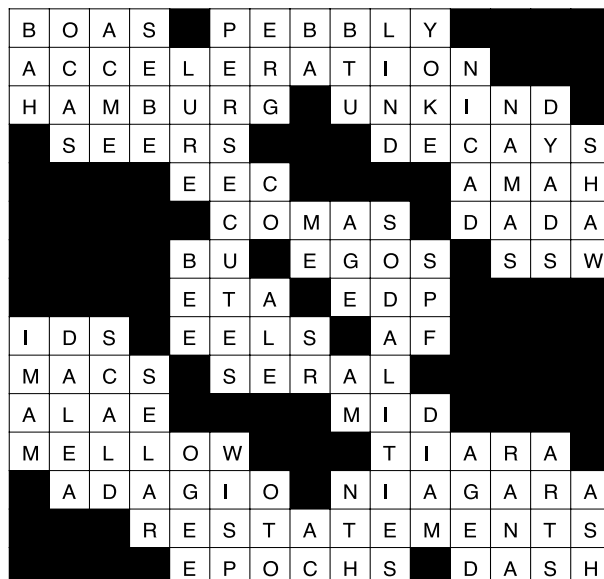
## The Sun OBITUARY POLICY
