RE: Heavy Commercial Vehicle Exclusion on Spring Street, Hartford Street, Smith Street & Ludlow Road

Notice is hereby given Pursuant to Article IX, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, of the Bylaws of the Town of South Hadley, the Selectboard hereby establishes the following rule:

The use and operation of heavy commercial vehicles, having a carrying capacity of more than 2 1/2 tons, are hereby restricted on Spring Street, Hartford Street, Smith Street and Ludlow Road.

Exemptions: this Section shall not apply to heavy commercial vehicles going to or coming from

places upon said streets for the purpose of making deliveries of goods, materials, or merchandise to or similar collections from abutting land or buildings or adjoining streets or ways to which access cannot otherwise be gained; or to vehicles used in connection with the construction, maintenance and repair of said streets or public utilities therein; or to Federal, State, Municipal or public service corporation owned vehicles.

The Selectboard as Licensing Authority will

hold a public hearing on said exclusion on **March 7, 2023 at 7:05 p.m.** at 45 Dayton St. The hearing will be held in a hybrid fashion with the opportunity for both in-person attendance and remote participation in accordance with Chapter 107 of the Acts of 2022 which extended the Governor's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, M.G.L. c.30A § 20, until March 31, 2023. Please note that while an option for remote attendance and/or participation is being provided as a courtesy to the public, the meeting/hearing will not be suspended or terminated if technological problems interrupt the virtual broadcast, unless otherwise required by law. Members of the public with particular interest in any specific item on this agenda should make plans for in-person or virtual attendance accordingly. For purposes of in-person attendance, the Selectboard will host the meeting in the multi-purpose room with remote participation details noted below.
