Notice is hereby given Pursuant to Article IX, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, of the Bylaws of the Town of South Hadley, the Selectboard hereby establishes the following rule:

The use and operation of heavy commercial vehicles, having a carrying capacity of more than 2 ½ tons, are hereby restricted on Spring Street, Hartford Street, Smith Street and Ludlow Road.

Exemptions: this Section shall not apply to heavy commercial vehicles going to or coming

places upon said streets for the purpose of making deliveries of goods, materials, or merchandise to or similar collections from abutting land or buildings or adjoining streets or ways to which access cannot otherwise be gained; or to vehicles used in connection with the construction, maintenance and repair of said streets or public utilities therein; or to Federal, State, Municipal or public service corporation owned vehicles.

The Selectboard as Licensing Authority will hold a public hearing on said exclusion on March 7, 2023 at 7:05 p.m. at 45 Dayton St. The hearing will be held in a hybrid fashion with the opportunity for both in-person attendance and remote participation in accor-

dance with Chapter 107 of the Acts of 2022 which extended the Governor's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, M.G.L. c.30A § 20, until March 31, 2023.
