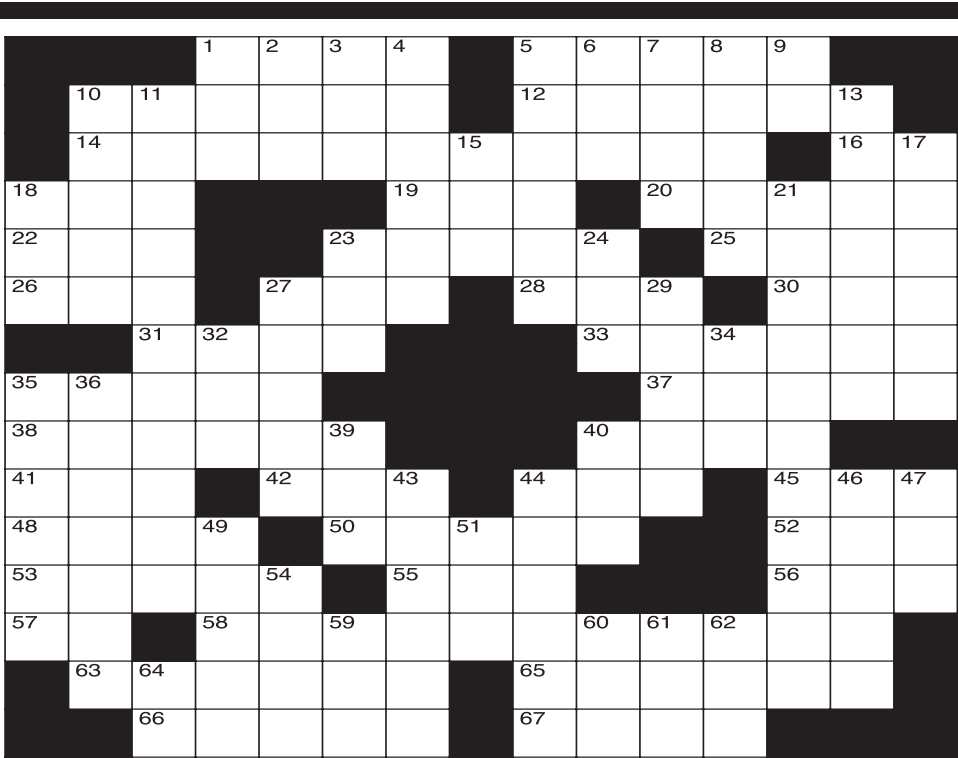
One is a free, brief Death Notice listing the name of deceased, date of death and funeral date and place.
