The Select Board will hold a Public Hearing on **Tuesday, September 08, 2026 at 5:45 PM** at the **Senior Center Building located at 10-B West State Street, Granby, MA to grant permission to Massachusetts Electric Company, d/b/a National Grid to locate poles, wires, and fixtures, including the necessary sustaining and protecting fixtures, of said poles to be erected substantially in accordance with the plan filed herewith marked — Pleasant St- Granby Massachusetts

1. Pleasant St. - National Grid

to install (2) SO poles on Pleasant St. beginning at a point approximately 150 feet south of the centerline of the intersection of East St. Installing 2 new poles; 26-25 and 26-25-84 for new service to 154 Pleasant St., Pole 26-25 will be installed on the West side of Pleasant St approximately 85 ft north of existing Pole 26 and approximately 60 ft south of existing Pole 26-50. Pole 26-25-84 will be installed on the east side of Pleasant St approximately 30 ft east of Pole 26-25.

Also, for permission to lay and maintain underground laterals, cables, and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings as each of said petitioners may desire for distributing purposes.

The petitioner agrees to reserve space for one cross-arm at a suitable point on each of said poles for the fire, police, telephone, and telegraph signal wires belonging to the municipality and used by it exclusively for municipal purposes.
